DO I QUALIFY FOR AN ELDERLY EXEMPTION?

- → The Elderly Exemption is income and asset based.
- Bartlett must be your primary (and most likely your only) domicile.
- → You must be 65 years old on April 1 of the tax year.
- → The income limits (annual) are \$20,000 for single and \$30,000 for married.
- → Your assets cannot exceed \$125,000.

Forms are available at the Selectmen's office or can be mailed. Documentation of income and assets must be provided, but will be returned to you. Applications must be filed by April 15 of the year of the tax.
