The next Selectmen's Meeting will be Monday, November 2, 2020 due to the General Election on Tuesday, 11/3/2020. NH DOT will be holding a hearing at the beginning of the meeting starting at 2:30 p.m. The hearing is for the preservation efforts on Bartlett Bridge Number 153/108 as part of the Bartlett Jackson 41989 project.

AA Lynn Jones reported that a complaint has been received regarding political flags being attached to tree on Hurricane Mountain Road possibly in the state's right of way. The state has been made aware of the concern.

Selectman Garland inquired if a complaint had been received regarding noise from a home based business near a rental property. None have been received at this time. Discussion of noise ordinances took place. Reviewed best procedure for a new zoning ordinance is to go through the Planning Board.
