Selectman Hebert made a motion at 03:35 PM to enter nonpublic session for a personnel issue per NH RSA 91-A: 3 II (a). Selectman Patch seconded the motion. Roll call vote was unanimous. - 4.) He proposes a 10% increase in his valuation.
- 5.) He doesn't want more pressure on his daughter by paying higher taxes.

Cobb Farm folks were in dealing with flood issues. A discussion was held concerning the dikes up by the Dugway. The Selectmen told them where the situation stood; things are in FEMA's hands at the moment.

The Selectmen had a discussion of the planning board getting involved in future flood planning.

Mr. Kevin McEnaney asked about the planning board decision re: pickle ball. Selectmen told him Selectmen didn't have an official status regarding the posting, etc. of Planning Board approved zoning amendment re: Pickle ball.

Selectmen voted to appoint Barry Trudeau (1DNDRD-128-H12) to be the Eastern Slope Airport authority (representative for the town) and we need to write a letter to him and airport authority regarding same.

The Selectmen reviewed and signed letters and building permits.
