The Selectmen received a telephone call from the town's attorney and legal issues were discussed.

Road Agent, Travis Chick, inquired from the Selectmen how they wanted him to handle the following situation. The highway department on Wednesday will be assisting the Bartlett Jackson Transfer Station by transporting their skid steer to a garage in Conway for repairs. The skid steer probably won't be available to be picked back up until Friday and the highway department doesn't work on Fridays. Selectman Garland stated that he guessed the transfer station will be without the skid steer until Monday, however, he suggested that Chick check with the garage on Thursday in case they happen to get it done by then. Selectman Garland also mentioned that if one of the workers for the highway department wants to come in on Friday and go pick up the skid steer that he doesn't have a problem with that. The road agent will check with his staff. Selectman Patch inquired about a purchase order that Chick had submitted for a new digging bucket for the backhoe. Chick explained that the new bucket would make work easier as it is a larger size. Selectman Patch stated that he would have to see where the money would come from as we hadn't budgeted for this expense. Chick commented that the bucket they have now is eight years old and has been welded several times. It is going to have to be welded again so that it is usable.

The Selectmen reviewed correspondence, building permits, signed letters and checks prior to and throughout the meeting.
