Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, February 24, 2021
Meeting via Zoom

Attendees: Chairman Gene Chandler, Selectman Vicki Garland, Selectman August Vincent

Meeting opened at 2:32 p.m.

Chairman Chandler and Selectman Vincent attended the meeting in person. Selectman Garland attended via Zoom due to COVID concerns.

Selectman Garland came to Town Hall on Tuesday, 2/23/2021 to sign checks, letters and building permits. Chairman Chandler and Selectman Vincent signed items throughout the meeting.

Chairman Chandler asked if everyone was ok with approving the minutes of 2/17/21. GGC – yes, VLG – yes, ADV – yes

Peter Gagne asked if there were any questions about his building permit that had been submitted. Chairman Chandler replied that it looked like they had everything they needed, but all three selectmen had not reviewed it yet.

Chairman Chandler mentioned that Selectman Vincent had questions regarding the faulty struts on the police cruiser. Selectman Vincent will talk directly with Police Chief Keaton about the issue.

Chairman Chandler mentioned that there were comments made to an employee of the Bartlett Jackson Transfer Station about the side effects of their vaccination and implied that vaccinations had been administered at the fire station for all town employees this week. There were no COVID 19 vaccinations administered at the fire station this week and it is unfortunate that misinformation was spread.

Chairman Chandler mentioned that the board will need to decide whether or not to use the ballot counter for the elections on May 11, 2021. The fee might be \$525 for the town and an additional cost for the school to use the counter in place of volunteers counting the ballots. There should be additional information available next week.

Selectman Vincent made a motion at 2:42 p.m. to enter nonpublic session for discussion of a personnel items per NH RSA 91-A:3 II (b). Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Roll call vote GGC – yes, VLG - yes, ADV – yes.

Selectman Vincent made a motion at 2:58 p.m. to end the nonpublic session. Selectman Garland seconded the motion. Roll call vote GGC – yes, VLG - yes, ADV – yes.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 2:58 p.m.
