Meeting Minutes: October 30, 2017

Meeting opened at 03:40 PM.

Selectman Hebert mentioned that he is planning on attending the Mt. Washington Valley Economic Council 27<sup>th</sup> annual meeting on November 16, 2017 at the Red Jacket Resort.

Selectman Hebert made a motion at 03:55 PM to enter nonpublic session per NH RSA 91-A: 3 II (c). Chairman Chandler seconded the motion. All in favor-motion carried. Selectman Hebert made a motion at 04:10 PM to end the nonpublic session.

David Woodward, Avitar Associates Assessor, informed the Selectmen that he dealt with about 95 people last Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. The data input is done and he did make some adjustments at Vista View, Partridge Woods, and Cathedral Trails. Selectman Hebert inquired as to when we might get our tax rate. Woodward stated that Lynn Jones, AA, has work to be done so it would probably be a couple of weeks. Chairman Chandler inquired if it would help if a statement that the work was done satisfactorily was written to Stephan Hamilton (NHDRA Commissioner). Woodward stated that Department of Revenue Administration (DRA, Auditor Phil Bodwell) has been monitoring what has been going on and that the Board of Tax and Land Appeals (BTLA) have been kept abreast of the process.

Selectman Hebert stated that he had an inquiry if the Bartlett Jackson Transfer Station would be accepting debris from the flood for free as they did last time during Tropical Storm Irene. The Selectmen discussed hours with the transfer station manager, Donald Miller, and decided that if people affected by flooding came and picked up haulers certificates that they could go to the transfer station three times a day for five days between the hours of 1:30 PM - 05:00 PM and not pay a disposal fee.

Selectman Hebert made a motion at 04:55 PM to enter nonpublic session to review legal advice (pickleball) per NH RSA 91-A: 3 II (k). Chairman Chandler seconded the motion. Roll call vote—unanimous-motion carried. Selectman Hebert made a motion at 05:20 PM to seal the minutes and end the nonpublic session. Chairman Chandler seconded the motion. Roll call vote-unanimous-motion carried.

The Selectmen signed checks, reviewed building permits and correspondence throughout the meeting. There being no further business the meeting was closed at 05:25 PM.
