Bartlett/Jackson Recycling Center and Transfer Station GENERAL INFORMATION

The Bartlett/Jackson Recycling Center and Transfer Station is located on Route 16, just north of Story Land on the Bartlett/Jackson town line. The hours of operation are from:

Monday, Tuesday, Friday – 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm Saturday and Sunday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm Closed Wednesday and Thursday

These hours apply to all days except Christmas day when they are closed. Closed Christmas eve at 04:00 PM.

Transfer Station stickers are **mandatory** and must be on your vehicle. These stickers can be obtained thru the Town Clerk-Tax Collector Office during normal business hours. They can also be obtained by submitting a transfer station sticker request form located on the office door and **sent with a self-addressed stamped envelope**. Bartlett residents are allowed 2 stickers per property (no matter how many vehicles are registered.) If you have more than 2 vehicles you may choose which 2 to take to the transfer station.

Items to be Recycled:

Glass - All food and beverage glass bottles and jars. Wash food residue out of all containers. Window #1

<u>Aluminum beverage cans</u> – All beer and soda cans only. Make sure all containers are clean and empty. Put in window #7.

Tin/Steel/Bi-metals cans and empty aerosol cans, also aluminum food tins - Please wash. Window #5

Plastics – Window #2 - Pigmented HDPE #2

Laundry detergent, maple syrup containers, coffee containers, shampoo bottles. Bottles no larger than 2.5 gallons or smaller than 5 oz.

Window #3 - PET/PETE #1

Carbonated beverage bottles, water bottles, fruit juice, tea etc. Bottles no larger than 2.5 gallons or smaller than 5 oz.

Window #4 - Unpigmented HDPE #2

Milk containers, tea containers etc.

Bottles no larger than 2.5 gallons or smaller than 5 oz.

All other plastics should be included with your regular household trash.

<u>Florescent Light Bulbs</u> – All mercury containing devices must be removed and has to be kept separate. Ballasts are also to be removed and recycled separately.

<u>Paper - Magazines</u>, window envelopes, office paper shredded paper in non plastic bags, cereal boxes, and beer boxes goes in window #6. Newspapers & inserts (not bundled) go in window #8. (No window envelopes or shredded paper) Any paper product made to go into the refrigerator or freezer (wet strength) goes into the trash.

<u>Corrugated cardboard</u> – all boxes except cereal/detergent/pizza boxes. Flatten cardboard boxes. No Aseptic boxes, no juice boxes, milk cartons, broth boxes, etc. (these go in the trash) Window #9

<u>Scrap metal</u> – All metal items including car parts, appliances, metal roofing. We <u>DO NOT</u> accept whole cars. No paint cans, no microwaves, no freon applicances or any applicance that has mercury in it (ie: anything with a thermal coupler) see attendant for microwaves and refrigerators

<u>Used Motor Oil</u> – Please include <u>only</u> used motor oil. Oil in jugs or bottles only. Commercial generators should call about disposal. Please label "used oil for recycling". Straight oil only. Absolutely **no** anti freeze.

<u>Motor Vehicle Batteries</u> – All wet-cell batteries from cars, trucks, motorcycles, etc. Use caution handling batteries. Place in designated area.

Rechargeable Batteries – All rechargeable batteries must be recycle; including lithium, alkaline, hearing aid, etc.

<u>Brush Pile</u>— Brush up to 5" in diameter. Materials may be taken to the brush burning area <u>only</u> after checking with attendant. No truck bed or trailer longer than 12'.

<u>Leaf & Yard Waste</u> – <u>Clean</u> – empty all containers and bags.

<u>Household Hazardous Waste</u> (Including oil based paints, oven cleaners, insecticides, herbicides, solvents, and other poisons) are <u>NOT</u> accepted at the facility during the year. Bartlett/Jackson residents are eligible to participate annually in a Household Hazardous Waste collection day. Please store materials safely at your home until collection day.
