

ORDINANCE

By virtue of the authority vested in the Selectmen of the Town of Bartlett by R.S.A. Chapter 41:11 and R. S. A. 47:17, Section VII

It is hereby ordered that between November 1 and May 1 no person or persons shall park, cause to be parked, leave or abandon, a motor vehicle upon the streets or public highway within the Town of Bartlett which would impede the removal of snow or the maintenance of the streets and highways.

Any constable, sheriff, deputy sheriff, or other official may cause any vehicle so parked or abandoned removed from the way and placed in a suitable parking place at the expense of the owner of such vehicle. Neither the town nor the official concerned shall be liable for any damage which may be caused by such removal.

The person removing said vehicle shall have the right to hold the same until all charges are paid.

Any person violating the aforesaid ordinance shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$50.00.
